This means they come with a fresh install of Windows, and some basic freely available software, but no other software like Microsoft Office. Don't worry though, organizations like TechSoup often have great deals on software for non-profits.

Why Are We Doing This?

It's simple—we want to support community groups who do amazing work in Christchurch. If you're a not-for-profit organization and think some free computers could make a difference, don't miss this chance.

Things to Keep in Mind

Here's a quick rundown of the Terms and Conditions:

- No warranties: The computers are free, but we can't guarantee how long they'll last. Many of them are running an operating system called Windows 10. After October 2025 Microsoft will be asking for a small fee to keep them secure.
- Once they're handed over, we will do our best to support them, but in some cases we may not be able to fix them cost-efficiently.
- We will only ask that you provide a quote and we have a photo together. In some cases we will use these for PR purposes.

How to Apply

Because the number of computers is limited, we can't guarantee that everyone who applies will get one. Decisions will be based on how much your organization and community could benefit from the device.
